Gross Pay	£500.00
Deductions from your wage required by law:	Income tax (£51.92) Employee National Insurance (£39.72)
Any other deductions or costs from your wage:	None
Student Loan Plan 1	£11.44
Example net take home pay:	£396.92

If you have a Student Loan Plan 2, the following net pay would be:

Student Loan Plan 2	£0
Example net take home pay:	£408.36

If you have a Postgraduate Loan, the following net pay would be:

Student Loan Postgraduate Loan	£5.77
Example net take home pay:	£402.59

Example rate of pay (incl. Holiday Pay):	£100.00 per day
Days worked	5
Gross Pay	£500.00
Deductions from your wage required by law:	Income tax (£51.92) Employee National Insurance (£39.72) Attachment of Earnings Order (£61.25)
Example net take home pay:	£347.10

EXAMPLE PAY

(with pension contributions)

All example pays are based on tax code 1250L W1/M1

Example rate of pay (incl. Holiday Pay):	£100.00 per day
Days worked	5
Gross Pay	£500.00
Deductions from your wage required by law:	Income tax (£51.92) Employee National Insurance (£39.72) Pension contributions (£19.00)
Example net take home pay:	£389.36

Example net take home pay:	£408.36
